

Summary: "The Sweet Shoppe" contains 40 full size images. It measures 10 x 11 inches and is sewn into heavy textured cover with pink foil accents. Featuring heavily shaded, vintage inspired line drawings, this book is appropriate for adult colorists on all skill levels. Paper: The paper in this book is cream colored and fairly heavy (think scrapbooking weight). All pages are single sided and non-perforated. All mediums are okay to use, but wet products may bleed through. Be sure to place several blotter sheets under your current picture to prevent further color transfer. Artwork: As the title implies, "The Sweet Shoppe" focuses on a variety of vintage candies and confectionaries. Inside you'll see old soda fountains, candy stores, and sweets of all kinds, including conversation hearts, chocolate coins, licorice allsorts, and bonbons. There is a huge amount of detail in every picture, and print quality is well done. All of the images do end before reaching the edges of the page, so they can be removed without any issues. Overall, this is a really unique book with a nice selection of candy to satisfy any sweet tooth. It would be best suited for colorists who enjoy vintage or food

related imagery.

This is another very interesting book. I did not know if I would like it, but I do. There is a lot of detail, but you can color it more like gray scale, which means it looks like you have a lot more artistic talent than you really do. It is a fun book to look at, and takes you back to a bygone era. It is a book like the "Curiosity Shoppe" The same style and artist but relating to sweets and sweet shops from the same era. I love it when artists put out more than one book. When I get used to a new style, I usually want more. Coloring is fun, but I also see it as new adventures. I would rate both books as gray scale, which is a lot of fun to color. I love learning new coloring techniques. To learn gray scale I would recommend the book "Spellbinding Images" by Nikki Burnette. She even has lessons on YouTube using her book, which also covers backgrounds. Another good book from a talented artist.
