

This is a pretty book. Some of the images are breathtaking, and some are unique and great for research. Other than that, the book's flat and stale. It's stretched to its 192 pages with doubled images and chapters with only one or two really relevant pictures. The text is sparse throughout, and only amounts to a very generalized overview of 100 years of fashion - the book omits some very prominent designers and trends. I got this book for two dollars. I don't think it's worth much more than that. It's pretty. That's all.

Icons of Fashion: The 20th Century is a very edgy and sophisticated book. It takes on a unique

approach about the icons of the 20th century. The content of this book is not in chronological order but rather in theme and designer ranging from the 1900s to 2000. To details of the pictures to the interesting facts of the earliest designers made me want to read more about the book. Reading about the designers, on the side of the book, there is a timeline about their life and businesses, which was really helpful, considering I had to write an assignment about the different designers and I could just refer back to the timeline. Yes, there are the icons of fashion to testify to these changes: Chanel, Karan and others - but also fine photos capturing styles ranging from body stockings to military and cocktail dress; all contained in an excellent overview blending visuals with a running commentary on fashion's influence.

This book reads worse than a textbook. Each (tiny) section, covering a few years to a decade's worth of fashion, is written by a different author, giving it a completely disjointed and non-comprehensive point-of-view. Might be good if you only need strict facts.
